

Parents,

Please make sure that you are scheduling your parent conferences. Conferences should be scheduled at least 2 to three times per year.

Here are a list of items you may include in your conference discussion:

1. Discuss the teachers grading procedures/methods.
2. How often is homework assigned?
3. Discuss your child's academic progress, which will include:
test grades, turning homework, completing daily assignments and other classroom activities. Ask if she offers after school tutorial assistance?
4. If my child is struggling, what focus intervention/ strategies have been used to improve his/her performance? Is retesting an option if my child is failing?
5. Discuss your child's learning style and also ask about the different strategies used in the classroom to meet my child's individual learning style.
6. Discuss your child's classroom behavior
7. Assigned seats. Make sure that your child is sitting where he/she can get the maximum amount of instructional learning. Sitting in the back of the classroom does not guarantee that he she is receiving optimum instructions.
8. Finally, make sure that all teachers have your current contact information so that you can be notified immediately if any problems occur.
